The word patriotism comes from the Latin patria, which means homeland or fatherland.

The first public Fourth of July event at the White House occurred in 1804.

The first Independence Day celebration west of the Mississippi occurred at Independence Creek and was celebrated by Lewis & Clark in 1805.

The origin of Uncle Sam probably began in 1812, when Samuel Wilson was a meat packer who provided meat to the U.S. Army. The meat shipments were stamped with the U.S. Someone joked that the initials stood for "Uncle Sam". This joke eventually leads to the idea of Uncle Sam symbolizing the United States government.

Independence Day acquired its unofficial theme song on July 4, 1897, at the Manhattan Beach Music Hall on the eastern end of Coney Island. On that Sunday afternoon, sometime after 4:00 p.m., John Philip Sousa lifted his baton and cued his band to launch into their latest hit, "The Stars and Stripes Forever". Sousa had not composed it specifically for the holiday, but it has been a marching-band staple on every Fourth of July since 1897.
